## **PREMIER NEW JERSEY MOVING COMPANY COMMITTS TO FIGHTING HUNGER IN THE LOCAL COMMUNITY**

**JERSEY CITY, NJ – Alpha Moving & Storage**, a premier relocation company in New Jersey, has committed to fighting hunger in their community by partnering with the national hunger relief organization, **Move For Hunger**. As part of their national network, Alpha Moving & Storage joins Move For Hunger’s force of relocation companies: to date, they have delivered more than **7 million pounds of food – 6 million meals** – to local food banks throughout the United States and Canada. **Food insecurity affects more than 1 million people in New Jersey; 1 in 6 children in the state goes to bed hungry each night.** Alpha Moving & Storage, who provides relocation services throughout the state, recognized the urgency of their neighbors’ needs and joined Move For Hunger to continue the fight against hunger and spread awareness of the growing need in New Jersey and across the United States.

When people move, they often throw out a good deal of “stuff.” Unfortunately, much of this stuff is food that could be delivered to a family in need rather than just left behind. **The crew of Alpha Moving & Storage will now be collecting those food items from their customers and delivering them directly to the local community food bank.** The service is free to customers and turns every move into an opportunity to make a difference in the lives of the less fortunate, simply by donating the cans and non-perishables on moving day.
